

2025 IMECE student travel award competition

With funding from the Haythornthwaite Foundation*, the Executive Committee (EC) of the Applied Mechanics Division (AMD) of ASME is pleased to announce the **2025 IMECE student travel award competition**.

Students can self-nominate and are required to send a brief one-page CV, a recommendation letter from the student's Faculty Advisor or Department Chair, the abstract of a paper accepted for presentation at [IMECE 2025](#) in Track 13 or Track 8, and a draft presentation. Please note that, at the time of the award presentation, the applicant must be enrolled full-time in a degree program at a US institution. A Faculty Advisor may not endorse more than one student. The nominations will be reviewed by the AMD EC. **Ten** students will be selected for travel grants of \$1000 each.

Dates:

September 15, 2025: Submit the nomination, by e-mail, to Professors **Narayana Aluru** <aluru@utexas.edu> and **Yashashree Kulkarni** <ykulkarn@central.uh.edu>.

The nomination should include: (a) CV of the applicant (one page); (b) Title and abstract of a paper accepted for presentation in Track 13 or Track 8 at IMECE 2025; (c) Recommendation letter from the Faculty Advisor or Department Chair.

October 15, 2025: Travel awards will be announced to the winners.
